

TEXAS CONFERENCE OF CLUBS
SUMMER MEETING
July 22, 2001

The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Malone at 1:00 p.m. at the Buzzards' Peak Community Landsite. The Chairman asked all present to observe a moment of silence for our ill and departed brothers and sisters.

Secretary Danny Burden called the roll. Heart of Tx. Bears – Ed Burleson, Leather Knights – David Young, Lone Star Leathermen – Jack Hanson, TCC Indep. (A) – Hal Pryor, TCC Indep. (B) – Jim Pascoe and TCC Indep. (C) – Dale Arndt. The Dallas MC, Houston Area Bears, Lancers and Texas MC were absent. With 10 member Clubs and Independents represented a quorum was declared and the meeting continued.

The Conference welcomed visitors Randal L., Steve H. with Lonestar Nudist Gp., Keeton L., Jorge G. Chain of Command Pledge, Susan H., Paula W., Lonnie W. and Craig M. all with Knot Just Leather, Matt D. with Discipline Corp and Jack H.

The Secretary's Report was not read due to a motion made by Hal P. and seconded by Jim P. to dispense with the reading of the report. Applications for the following Club and Independent Members were voted on and accepted as members of TCC: Discipline Corp of Dallas, TCC Indep. Jack Hutchinson, Ray Harting, Todd McKinny (Mr. Lonestar 2001) and Blake White. The SA/SM group has asked to have their deposit returned rather than held over for 2002 as previously requested. The Dallas MC has submitted contracts and deposit for a Run Oct. 12 – 14. Rosebud Run will be titled "In The Dark". The Knot Just Leather group have submitted contracts and deposit for a Run to be held Sept. 7-9. The Run shall be called Knot Just Leather's "Sadistic September". The Colt 45's have requested the return of a \$2000 donation for the Out Door stage. The two year deadline has expired and monies due Colt 45's shall be returned. Mike Salavarria, TCC Indep. made a donation of \$100 toward the electrical wiring project for the Tent Camping areas. The Conference thanks Mike for his generous donation.

Due to an accident at home the Treasurer Jim Williams was unable to attend the meeting. He did send the Treasurers Report for inspection by Officers and Delegates. The Report was accepted as presented.

Lonestar 14 Coordinator Danny B. presented the books to the Conference with funds totalling \$2717.00 from the run. He also presented the Conference with \$240.00 usage fee from the July Unrun. Lonestar 15 Coordinator Chris Love reported everything is going as planned for FIRESTAR 15 with applications available now. Land Management Chairman Hal Pryor presented the following recommendations to the Conference for their approval. A \$10 charge for each campsite using electrical hookup per weekend usage. For using space in the Bunkhouse each person will pay \$15 fee for a 3 or 4 day event. This recommendation passed with one opposed – Jim S. Using the TCC Trailor for 3 or 4 day event at a rate of \$20. This also passed with one opposition – Jim S. The Conference accepted all the recommended charges with noted opposition. The LMC recommended the Conference purchase a 25 gal. Sprayer for bug and pest protection at a price of approximately \$350.00. The recommendation passed with two opposed Jack H. and Jim S. LMC recommended the Conference purchase (4) sheets of plywood to close in the back of the kitchen to prevent rain and weather from damaging equipment. This motion was passed with the stipulation that their must be hinges attached for removal during hot weather periods. LMC recommended that a Non-member Club or individual pay a \$10 per-person usage fee for the property, effective 01/01/02 . Motion carried with one opposition - David Y. Property Usage for other than approved runs members will pay \$5.00 daily and Non-members will pay \$7.00 daily. Motion carried with three (3) opposed.
