

# Spring Quarterly Report

## April 17, 2004

### Land Management

#### Old Business

- Bathroom – Continued research is being done on building design, wastewater treatment, and location of new facility.
- Kitchen – No further action has been made on new kitchen facility.
- Compound – Added play areas have been started up the hill in the “Screamers Peak” area. Continued clean up and improvements to compound area are in progress.
  - Electrical – New power point has been added on the south side of the road west of the kitchen. This point will serve addition campsites as well as RV/Pop-up campers along the road in the old dumpster location. New Connection for walk-in-cooler has been made to different power point. Improvements are more capacity at pole barn and reduced demand charges on utility bill.  
New connection for deep fryers in kitchen.

#### New Business

- Proposal of display board of member clubs has been approved to install on Shower wall (John S.)

#### Maintenance

- Grounds – Many plants and landscape has been done in the area around the showers and the field. Continued clean up of leaves and fallen trees has been done. Removal of tree at entrance of field.
- Equipment – All equipment is in general good condition and in working order.
- Insect and pest control is an immediate concern. The “fire” ants are very active and we have a large infestation of them this year.
- The septic system experienced some overflow problems at the last activity weekend. A pit was dug at the end of the septic line to provide a sump to relieve the system.
- Installation of gravel in the picnic area.
- Power washing and painting of picnic tables.
- Perimeter Trail clearing.
