Stan talked about repairs done since the last meeting. Walk-in system had a minor leak. New warmer in the kitchen. Intermittent problem with control board. \$650 to replace board. Shower head replaced in women's shower; septic tank pumped out. Drainage issue in kitchen, ice machine not performing. Making too large a cube of ice. Adjusted size of cubes, working well now. Med shed a/c is shot and was replaced with a donated unit.

Stan reminded run coordinators they are responsible for their firewood, not TCC. Cleaning of property line trail, lots of dead wood.

Items left every run. Run coordinators ask campers to check site. All garbage needs to be disposed of. Opening meeting to let TACC rep go over safety issues, etc.

Campers trespassing on private property. Rates for TCC. Camper fee from \$15 to \$20, cabins to \$50 for the weekend. \$25 night for casual camping. Popup is \$40.

New sink installed by coffee urns so campers can wash their hands before going through the food line.
