

Casual Camper Program

Purpose

This document shows the policies, procedures, and rules for casual use of the Landsite.

Statement of Policy

It is the policy of the Texas Conference of Clubs the landsite be available for the use of individual members of member organizations, TCC Independents, and their guests, for casual use and camping on a non-interference basis with events scheduled on the TCC calendar.

Definition of Terms

Casual Camper: any member of a member organization, TCC Independent, and their guests, using the landsite facilities other than attendance at an event scheduled on the TCC calendar.

Day User: any casual visit that does not include an overnight stay.

Overnight Camper: any visit that includes an overnight stay.

Reservations: reservations for casual camping are not available; camping is on a first come, first served basis.

Policy Details

Landsite Access: contact our Facilities Coordinator, or our on-site Caretaker if the Facilities Coordinator is unavailable, to arrange for your stay. Do not show up without making prior arrangements. Do not assume the facilities are open or the Facilities Coordinator or Caretaker will be at the landsite when you arrive. The TCC website, www.texasconferenceofclubs.com, has contact information.

Stay Limits: Causal Camper and Overnight Camper stays are limited to a maximum of seven (7) continuous days. You may arrange a longer stay through the Facilities Coordinator.
